

**FATHER ATTACHMENT AND SUBJECTIVE WELL BEING OF COLLAGE
STUDENTS IN YOGYAKARTA**

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ABSTACT

This research aims to know how relations of father attachment and subjective well-being toward college student in Yogyakarta. This research using two scale for subjective well-being's variable and one scale for father attachment. Scale that has been used is a) satisfaction with life scale who made by Diener, Emmons, Larsen and Griffin (1985) b) positive and negative affect scales by Watson, Clark and Tellegen (1988) c) Father attachment scale whom developed by Armsden and Greenberg (1987). The result using product moment pearson correlation method analysis show that a positive relations between father attachment and subjective well-being with $r = 0,469$ and $p = 0,000$ ($p < 0,05$), it mean higher attachment, will make college have subjective well-being higher too. Based on this research result, that hypothesis that say there was a positive relations between father attachment and subjective well-being has been accepted or it mean H_0 rejected.
