CHAPTER II

CONSTRUCT

Give students opportunities to communicate. Give students direction, and provide information, and student have been conditioned only to "speak when spoken to". Part of oral communication competence is the ability to initiate conversation, to nominate topics, to ask questions, to control conversations, and to change the subject. (Brown,1994)
