

THE CORRELATION BETWEEN TIME MANAGEMENT AND DISCIPLINE ATTITUDE TO THE INTRINSIC MOTIVATION OF STUDENTS AT SMK NEGERI 1 CANGKRINGAN

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ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the relationship between time management and discipline simultaneously on the intrinsic motivation of class X students majoring in Laboratory Research Analysis at SMKN 1 Cangkringan. The population in the study were 206 students majoring in Laboratory Research Analysis from class X to class XII. The sample consisted of 69 students of class X APL 1 and X APL 2. The sampling technique used was purposive sampling. The collection technique was carried out using a non-test method in the form of a questionnaire. The data analysis technique used is the correlation test. The hypothesis test used is the parametric statistical test, namely the multiple correlation test. The results of this study indicate that there is a significant relationship between time management and discipline simultaneously with the intrinsic motivation of students at SMKN 1 Cangkringan with a significance value of 0.000 and a correlation coefficient of 0.533 where the three variables have a moderate correlation level.
